As the school year draws to a close, we are working on several social events including Memorial Day and July the 4th celebrations. We look forward to seeing you all there! Details to follow.






EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT V.I.P. (VOLUNTEERS IN PATROL)

- 1
- **Volunteers In Patrol (VIP)** is PHA's neighborhood patrol program designed to help reduce crime through increased cooperation with DPD off duty Police Officers. The VIP functions as a vital part of our Public Improvement District (PID). The PID program is a 24/7 dedicated Dallas Police presence exclusively on call for Prestonwood residents. They ensure home safety every day and will provide vacation wellness checks at your home.

- VIP patrollers are trained by DPD officers to patrol our streets and alleys on a bi-weekly basis of our neighborhood ensuring garage doors are closed ensuring our homeowner's safety.

- In the event a garage door is left open, we contact the homeowner to make them aware. If the homeowner doesn't answer our call, our Patrollers will contact the PID Officer, so they can provide a wellness check at the residence.

- Our Homeowners' safety is our # 1 Priority. Please remember to close your garage doors, close and lock the gates to your yard and report any suspicious activities to the PID Officer (mobile contact number 972-333-3441) or call 911 if deemed necessary.

- The next VIP Training, is scheduled for June 2022 (day & time TBD) at the North Central Police Substation in the Community Room. This is located at McCallum and Hillcrest. 


