

### TAX LEVY NOTICE

The Prestonwood Homeowners Association (PHA) has had another highly successful year managing your Prestonwood Public Improvement District (PID) 24-hour security service.

Crime has been nearly non-existent due to our police security patrol with the presence of an armed Dallas police officer in uniform in a Dallas police car 24/7. This has proven to be a terrific crime deterrent and is a continuation of a long-term trend for our neighborhood.

Due to the rapidly increasing property values in the 2021 tax year and tight fiscal management and supervisory overview by the PHA, the PHA Board is pleased to announce a reduction in the PID assessment rate for 2022 from \$0.07 per \$100 of assessed value levied in 2021 to \$0.065 per \$100. As the active management of the PID, the PHA Board will continue to monitor assessed home values and set the PID assessment rate at a fair level to continue to provide the safety and security of our 24/7 police patrols.



## **PHA Poll Survey** Results 2022

This past summer, we sent out a survey to our current PHA members via email, capturing how best our HOA can serve our homeowners. Based on the 142 household responses, here are some of the highlights:

- 35% have lived in Prestonwood less than 10 yrs whereas 25% over 31 years!
- 58% of members are either retired or have no kids living at home while **41**% have college, school or preschool aged children at home
- Maintenance ranked the highest for areas to focus efforts & resources
- 73% of respondents felt that the current \$85 annual fee was just right
- Music in the Park is the most preferred event to attend and on weekend evenings (coming this October!)
